AN ORDINANCE
CREATING THE PEOPLES LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB) OF THE MUNICIPALITY
OF MAGSAYSAY, DAVAO DEL SUR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Magsaysay, Davao del Sur,
that:

SECTION 1- The enactment of this Ordinance was made pursuant to the mandate of Section 43 of R.A. 6975 otherwise known as “ An act establishing the Philippines National Police under a Reorganized Department of the Interior and Local Government, and for other purposes as amended by R. A 8551.

SECTION 2 – There is hereby created a Peoples Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) for Magsaysay, Davao del Sur to be composed of the following:

- a.) One member of the Sangguniang Bayan chosen by his/her Sanggunian;
- b.) One Liga ng mga Barangay Representative;
- c.) Three other members who are removable only for cause to be chosen by the Municipal Peace and Order Council from among the respected members of the community known for their probity and integrity, one of whom must be a woman and another member of the Bar, or, in the absence thereof, a college graduate, or the district supervisor of the DepEd or the principal of the Central Elementary School in the locality;

The Chairman of the PLEB shall be elected from among its members.

SECTION 3 – The term of office of the members of the PLEB shall be for a period of three (3) years from assumption of office. Such member shall hold office until his successor has been chosen and qualified.

SECTION 4 – A secretary shall be designated who shall be responsible for documentation of the proceedings, preparation of reports and such other functions that may be required in the discharge of its functions.

SECTION 5 – PLEB Members and the Secretary shall be paid an honoraria in the amount of Php 1,000.00 for every meeting and shall be provided with a life insurance as mandated by law.

SECTION 6- The Local Government Unit shall include in its annual budget in an item and the corresponding appropriation for the maintenance and operation of the PLEB.

SECTION 7- Any member who resign, or remove for cause or unable to perform a mandated duty shall be replaced by the Municipal Mayor through Executive Order, who shall serve for the unexpired term.

SECTION 8- The Municipal Mayor shall by Executive Order, reorganize the PLEB when membership thereof has no longer have a majority by reason of inability, resignation, death or removal for cause or other members, who shall serve for the unexpired term.

SECTION 9- The selection in the replacement of members under Section 7 and reorganization under Section 8 of this ordinance shall be in accordance with the conditions provided in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 10- The PLEB members shall be appointed by the Municipal Mayor within Ten (10) days following the complete submission of the names of representatives of the sector concerned pursuant to the condition set forth in section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 11- The Municipal Mayor shall require the sectors concerned to submit the names of their representatives, to succeed the outgoing PLEB Members to be appointed as new PLEB Members.

SECTION 12- Any ordinance which is in conflict with the provisions herein provided are hereby modified, amended or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 13. – Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
