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AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BARANGAY EMPLOYMENT DESK OFFICER (BEDO) IN EVERY BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPLAITY OF MAGSAYSAY, DAVAO DEL SUR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Magsaysay, Davao del Sur that:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance establishing the Barangay Employment Desk Officer (BEDO).

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. The state shall provide full employment and quality opportunities for all thus improve quality of life; and for this purpose, to strengthen and expand existing employment desk by the Municipal Government of Magsaysay its barangays will enhance capability of its general public.

SECTION 3. OBJECTIVE. (a) In general, the Barangay Employment Desk shall be an extension of PESO and ensure the prompt, timely and efficient delivery of employment services and provisions of information to the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE); (b) Provide a venue where people in the Barangay could explore simultaneously various employment options and actually seek assistance they prefer; (c) Serve as referral and information center at the Barangay level for various services and programs of PESO, DOLE, TESDA and other government agencies present in the area and provide clients with adequate information on employment and labor market information in the Barangay.

Section 4. FUNCTIONS OF THE BED

O. The BEDO shall operate the area of jurisdiction in coordination with the PESO, DOLE, TESDA and other concerned agencies: a) shall establish a Skills Registry System and shall keep pertinent data relative to employment; b) shall provide career coaching and career guidance to the immediate stakeholders in the respective barangay particularly with the parents; c) shall be the frontline advocate in the implementation and conduct of the Anti-Human Trafficking Law; d) Shall assist the PESO in the re-integration services to returning OFW's; e) initiate and organize Job Fair conducted by the Barangay and shall supervise and monitor by the PESO pursuant to DOLE guidelines; f) initiate or organize livelihood and self-employment bazaars in coordination with government and non-government institutions undertaking livelihood and self-employment programs; g) endeavors to reach out to qualified poor but deserving students and out of school youth to preserve their education by facilitating their employment pursuant to RA 7323.

Section 5. OBLIGATIONS OF BARANGAY.

1. Provides honorarium, travel allowances and office supplies and other financial assistance and moral support to the BEDO in its effort to promote employment program in their Barangay;
2. Acknowledge the BEDO as part of the Barangay Worker for the implementation of Employment and other Programs.

Section 6. OBLIGATIONS OF LGU MAGSAYSAY. Allocate funds or budget as counterpart for the quarterly honorarium of the BEDO in the amount of One Thousand Pesos only (P1,000.00).

Section 7. REPEALING CLAUSE . All Ordinances, Executive Orders and Rules and Regulations inconsistent or in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are deemed repeated, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
